SUSTAINABLE OPERATIONS

Every Delicato bottling facility is certified by the California Sustainable Winegrowing Alliance, a comprehensive sustainability program of the California Wine Institute and the California Association of Grape Growers, utilizing a statewide standard of sustainability in both the wineries and in the vineyards.

BIODIVERSITY

The Delicato family has created a magnificent habitat, bursting with life, at the San Bernabe Vineyards in Monterey. Wild boar, coyotes, rabbits, gophers, badgers, deer, mountain lions, eagles, hawks, falcons, ducks, herons, starlings, vultures and a variety of fish have all taken up residence.

NATURAL RESOURCES

Last year, through lighting retrofit projects, wine tank insulation and participation in demand-response programs, we reduced our energy usage in Manteca by 14%. That's saving enough energy to power the electricity in 252 homes for one year, or the same as saving 145,580 gallons of gas.

SUSTAINABLE PACKAGING


Bag in the box packaging creates less waste than traditional glass packaging, with a recyclable outer carton and a BPA-free plastic pouch to keep the wine fresh. Bag-in-Box technology also eliminates TCA/cork taint and oxidation and keeps the wine fresh for at least a month after opening.

SUSTAINABLE HIGHLIGHT

\$100M Investment in Sustainable Wine Quality & Logistics: G4C Distribution & Production Center

- 700,000 sq. feet; 20M case capacity.
- Exceeds California's stringent Title 24 energy efficiency standards by more than 10%.
- Home to 11 different lines consisting of two glass lines, five BIB lines, one Tetra line and four flexible configuration lines to meet spike demand.
- Consolidation of our production and distribution centers saves over 20,000 gallons of diesel each year.
- Electrified forklift fleet.
- Highly efficient glycol refrigeration system.





Climate Adaptation Certification Pilot Program: Archimedes Vineyard

- Created by the California Land Stewardship Institute (CLSI)
- Goal: To limit CO2 and NO2 emissions while focusing on carbon sequestration to improve the health of the soil and farm
- Twenty growers in Sonoma County entered into the pilot program in 2020
- As of 2021, for the collective 20 sites in Sonoma County, up to 2,184 metric tons of CO2E can be removed annually via custom farming scenarios for each vineyard that sequester carbon specific to that land

SUSTAINABLE HIGHLIGHT

Bald Eagle Habitat: San Bernabe Vineyards

- In 2020, a vineyard development project was planned for a portion of San Bernabe Vineyards, focused on a beautiful area of land that would be perfect to plant Pinot Noir.
- During the planning, team members discovered a bald eagle's nest had been built in a tree right where the vineyard was planned to be planted.
- Our solution?
- Redesign the vineyard to safely buffer the tree and ensure the new residents' home remained protected and safe.
- Our eagles are still in residence today, safe and protected in their chosen habitat.





SUSTAINABLE NEXT STEPS

Sustainable Certification – Alba Coast Winery

- Delicato's wine storage facility located in Paicines,
 California (no bottling here)
- Initial sustainability certification with CSWA requires a two-year assessment and audit process
- Year 1 assessment underway; initial site audit completed May 2023
- Reaffirms and aligns Delicato's commitment to sustainable practices across all facilities
- Creates consistency among Delicato team for sustainable operational practices





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
